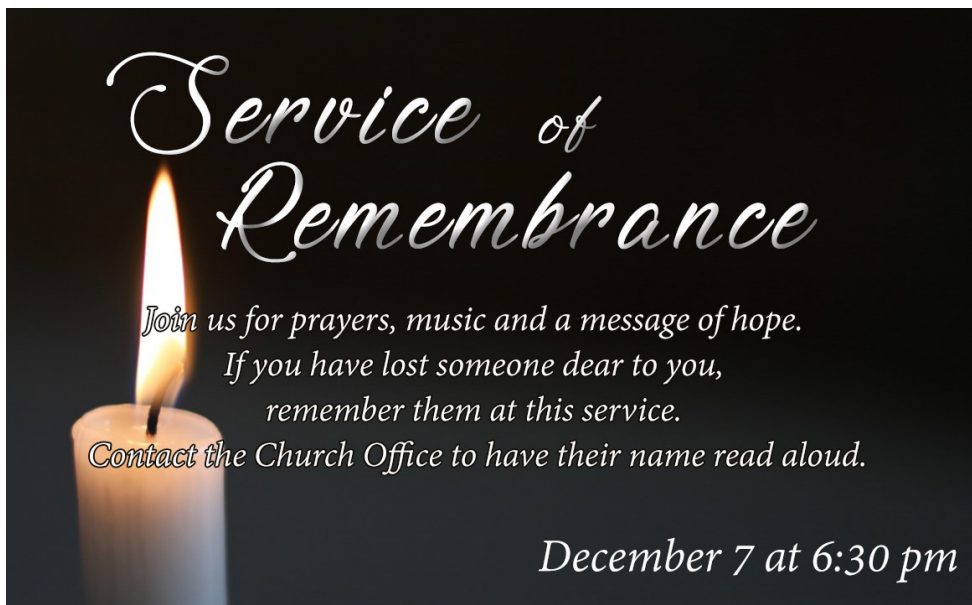

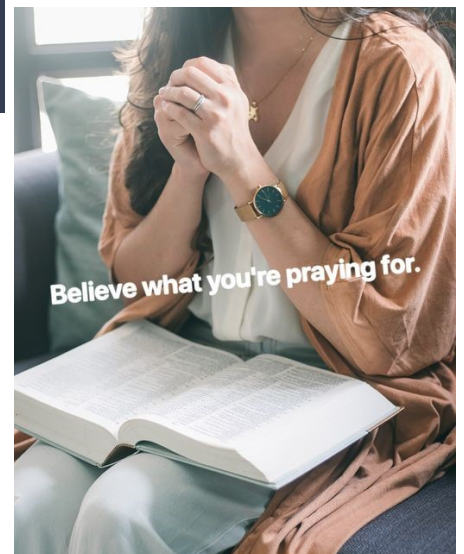

SURVIVE

- Food bags were provided to 125 families in the surrounding village.
- Hygiene kits were provided to each child. We are focused on supporting their healthcare and nutrition while at home.



THRIVE

- Education – School material bags and lessons were provided to children in lieu of limited access to internet and school supplies, so they are able to keep studying while they wait to return to school
- Teachers provided moral lessons focused on respect, honesty, fellowship, responsibility, and good communication



COMMUNITY OUTREACH

- 30 ladies (parents/guardians) gathered together for a fellowship activity by playing games, talking, and making hot chocolate together. La Cuchilla is located in an area where cacao seed is very popular, so creating chocolate dishes is a staple of the food culture in the area. Many of the ladies talked about how their mothers and grandmothers taught them how to make chocolate dishes, and even how they sold their products during Christmas to generate income. Some of the ladies sold their baked goods as a "thank you" gesture after their time together and bought plastic chairs as a gift to the CarePoint. The vision of the ladies is to see transformation and restoration through relationships, making fellowship important to fulfilling this vision. Amid a time of limited relationship building opportunities over the last few months, this was a very special and encouraging time for the women.

Risen Savior Monthly Financial Review

The following is a summary of financial activity for Risen Savior Lutheran Church. If you would like more detailed reports, please contact our Operations Manager, Susan Mello at susan.mello@rslcs.org.

Financial Summary for October 2020:

Below, you will see the details for the October financials. Please note that these results do not reflect the impact of our Paycheck Protection Loan.

Giving Results

Giving was **under** budget by (\$10,603) for the month of October and **under** budget by (\$78,781) CYTD20.

For CYTD20, we are holding steady at 94% of the budget for Giving. The shortfall is predominantly in Loose Plate giving.

Spending

Spending was **under** budget by (\$30,752) for the month of October and **under** budget by (\$192,377) CYTD20.

The Preschool has underspent due to control over variable costs such as food and labor that has been impacted by lower enrollment.

The Church has put controls in place to monitor expenses and adjust as needed based on Giving.

In light of the decrease in Giving and Preschool Revenue, we continue to monitor expenses and limit based on necessity.

Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was **under** budget by (\$16,692) for the month of October and **under** budget (\$135,741) CYTD20.

Current enrollment at the Preschool is approximately 75% of the pre-COVID-19 levels.

Net Operating Cash

As of October 31, 2020, Operating Cash is a **negative** (\$225,598), which is a decrease of (\$32,915) from the end of September.

Please note that this does NOT include the impact of the PPP Loan.

This is significantly below our budgeted position for this time of the year, but we are putting controls in place to limit the effect of this through the end of the calendar year.
