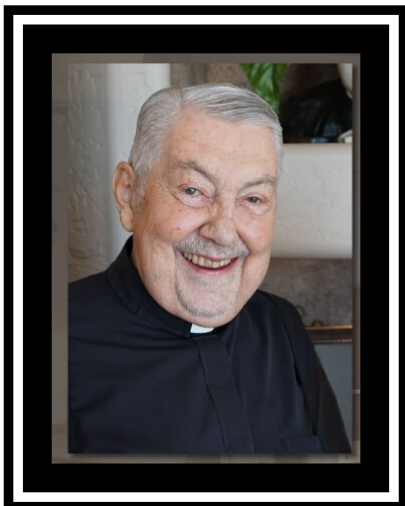
## Sunday Ministry Partner Sign-up Process

Our Sunday morning Service Team Leader positions are scheduled through Planning Center. We are using a tool in Planning Center called "Sign-up-Sheets". Rather than the office scheduling, now you will be able to choose which Sundays/services you'd like to serve.

At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.

We know that some of our married couples that use Planning Center share the same email address. If you do, here's what we need ONE of you to do: (One of you may keep your current password, but the other needs to create a new one). Enter the link to get to the sign-in page of Planning Center at <https://accounts.planningcenteronline.com>. Type in your email address and click the checkmark button. Remember, if you share an email address with another Planning Center user, you must keep track of which account you're accessing when you are signing up or making changes to your schedule.

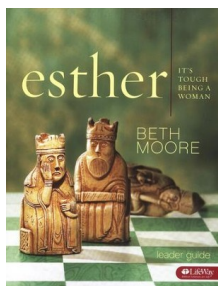

For 50 years, LAMP Ministry, Inc. has taken the Gospel to northern Canada where nearly 1,000,000 indigenous people live in isolated areas. They can be reached only by aircraft or on seasonal roads. About half of the population is under the age of 14. The LWML mite offerings were able to fulfill a Mission Grant of \$100,000 for partnering with Lamp to help provide more missionary pilots and more volunteers to bring Christ to this mission work in Canada.

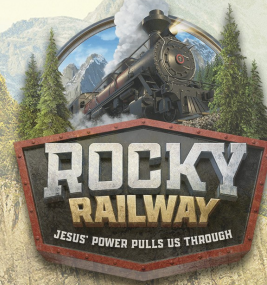

## Did you know?

We are in the third year of the “Our Next Step...” Capital Campaign. For many of you this will be the last year of the campaign for you. For some, who chose to give over 4 or 5 years, you are over halfway there. Below are the results of the Capital Campaign as of April 30, 2021.

Over 65% of the families who Pledged have completed at least 75% of their Pledge  
An additional 65 families who did not make a Pledge have donated \$234,871

We cannot begin to express our gratitude to everyone on this journey with us.

## Financial Summary for April 2021

### Giving Results

Giving was **under** budget by (\$557) for the month of April and is **under** budget (\$3,515) for CYTD2021.  
Tracked Giving was **over** by \$2,783 and Loose Plate was **under** by (\$3,340).

### Spending

Spending was **under** budget by (\$3,917) for the month of April and **under** budget (\$55,021) for CYTD2021.

### Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was **under** budget by (\$5,040) for the month of April and **over** budget \$2,083 for CYTD2021.

Current enrollment in the Preschool is at pre-COVID level.

### Net Operating Cash

As of April 30, 2021, Operating Cash is a **positive** \$56,440, which is a net **positive** change of \$16,367 from March 31, 2021

As a reminder, we end each year with a net zero Operating Cash. The previously reported positive year end Operating Cash was distributed to funds on the balance sheet by a vote of the Governing Board.
