### Sunday Ministry Partner Sign-up Process

At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.

These meetings consist of weekly bible studies, interactive games and socialization. See monthly series details below.




#### Impact (Grades 9-12)

# Risen Savior Monthly Financial Review

## Did you know?

Your contributions to ACSTO (Arizona Christian Scholarship Tuition Organization), provided scholarships for nearly 85% of our annual Kindergarten tuition. Thank you for your continued support of Christian education.

#### Financial Summary for May 2021

#### Giving Results

Giving was *under* budget by (\$8,000) for the month of May and is *under* budget (\$11,515) for CYTD2021.

Tracked Giving was *under* by (\$5,177) and Loose Plate was *under* by (\$2,823).

#### Spending

Spending was *over* budget by \$7,684 for the month of May and *under* budget (\$45,336) for CYTD2021.

#### Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was *under* budget by (\$9,577) for the month of April and *under* budget (\$7,493) for CYTD2021.

Current enrollment in the Preschool is at the pre-COVID level.

#### Net Operating Cash

As of May 31, 2021, Operating Cash is a *positive* \$33,014 which is a net *negative* change of (\$23,426) from April 30, 2021

As a reminder, we end each year with a net zero Operating Cash. The previously reported positive year end Operating Cash was distributed to funds on the balance sheet by a vote of the Governing Board.
