

#### Arizona Christian School Tuition Organization

If you're an Arizona taxpayer, you can make a donation to ACSTO and **receive a dollar-for-dollar state tax credit** in return! But what does that mean?

At the end of the year, if you typically get a refund, you'll get a bigger refund. If you typically owe, you'll owe less. This is because a tax credit is different than a normal charitable deduction—rather than reduce your taxable income, **it directly reduces your state tax liability** (a.k.a. the tax you pay). For example, if your tax liability (obligation) is \$1,000, and you make a \$750 donation to ACSTO, your liability will be reduced by \$750—meaning that your tax liability will only be \$250! Keep in mind, if you usually receive a refund, a tax credit makes it bigger—it is to your advantage to participate in this program.

In addition, you can make a donation all the way up until **April 15** (your donation must be made prior to filing your taxes—if you are filing an extension your donation needs to be made by April 15), and **still claim the credit for the previous tax year!** 

The best part? ACSTO uses your tax credit donation to award tuition scholarships to Christian School students attending one of our Partner Schools! When you make a donation, you can identify a specific school, or even recommend a specific student to be considered for a scholarship!

Because of your support, thousands of families, who otherwise couldn't, have been able to afford Christian Education—none of this is possible without you!

What are you waiting for? More than 85,000 Arizona taxpayers have already joined us to make Christian Education affordable for 38,000 students! Point the way for Arizona students today!

### **APRIL 15 DEADLINE**

Donations can be mailed or submitted online to ACSTO prior to filing taxes, but no later than April 15 (whichever comes first), and still be eligible for the tax credit for the previous tax year. For any donations made between January 1 and April 15, it is up to the donor to determine which tax year they will claim the donation. Donations must be postmarked or submitted online by midnight of April 15—even if you plan on filing an extension. Arizona law allows donors to recommend a student when making their donation, however, a recommendation is not a guarantee of a scholarship award. This is because Arizona law and ADOR regulations state that, "A school tuition organization cannot award, restrict, or reserve scholarships solely on the basis of a donor's recommendation." Recommendations are one of the three criteria our Selection Committees consider when making scholarship awards, in addition to the Financial Circumstances of the student's family (a required factor by state law) and the Narrative provided in the Scholarship Application.





The Arizona Christian School Tuition Organization (ACSTO) and the Arizona Lutheran Scholarship Organization (ALSO) merged last year.

If you pay Arizona state income taxes, you can make a donation to ACSTO and claim the amount you give as a dollar-for-dollar tax credit that lowers your bill. There is no out of pocket cost to you. Please go to: www.acsto.org to make your donation. <u>Remember to list Risen Savior Lutheran School as your</u> <u>recommended school.</u> These funds will directly impact our Kindergarten class here at Risen Savior's Early Childhood Center.

#### Paycheck Protection Loan

As you may recall, Risen Savior Lutheran Church applied for and was granted a Paycheck Protection Loan last year. This loan was then forgiven in full at the end of 2020. In the beginning of 2021, the program was extended and Risen Savior qualified for and received an additional Paycheck Protection Loan in the amount of \$300,970. We will hold this money aside until the qualifications for forgiveness have been met and submitted to the SBA for decision.

This is such a blessing to the ministry at Risen Savior and we give all the glory to God for this amazing gift!

#### Financial Summary for January 2021

Giving Results

Giving was *under* budget by (\$44,478) for the month of January.

Tracked Giving was under by (\$40,375) and Loose Plate was under by (\$4,373)

Spending

Spending was *over* budget by \$2,197 for the month of January.

For District Missions and our custodial service, both the January and February payments were made in January. There will no payment for these two items in February.

Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was *over* budget by \$7,142 for the month of January.

Current enrollment in the Preschool is now at pre-COVID level.

Net Operating Cash

As of January 2021, Operating Cash is a *negative (*\$30,599).

As a reminder, we end each year with a net zero Operating Cash. The previously reported positive year end Operating Cash was distributed to funds on the balance sheet by a vote of the Governing Board.
