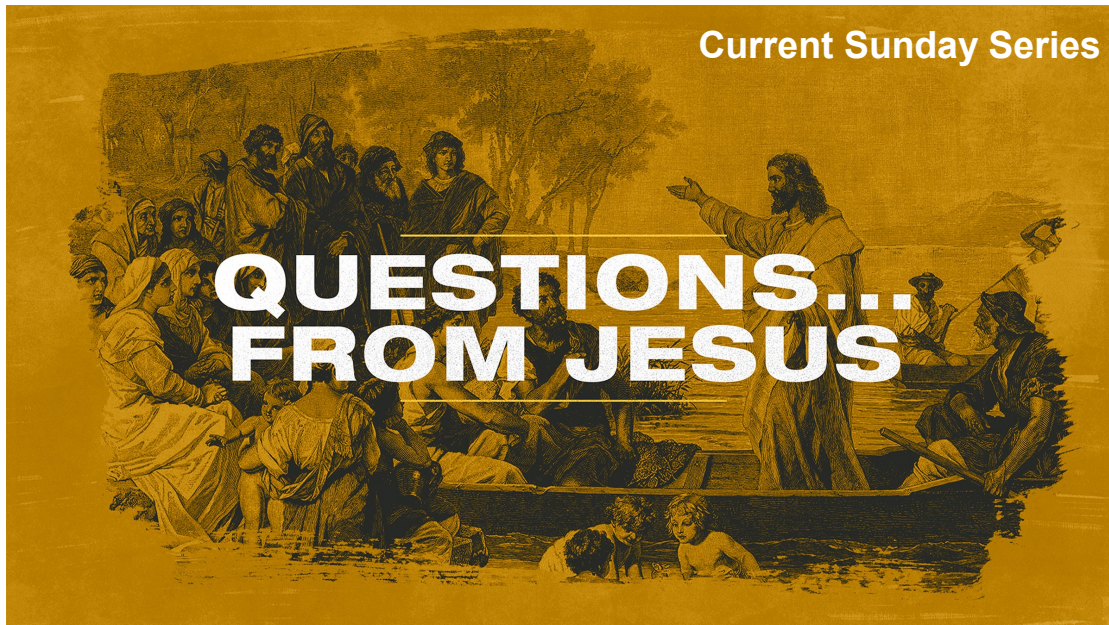

Piece Maker Quilters

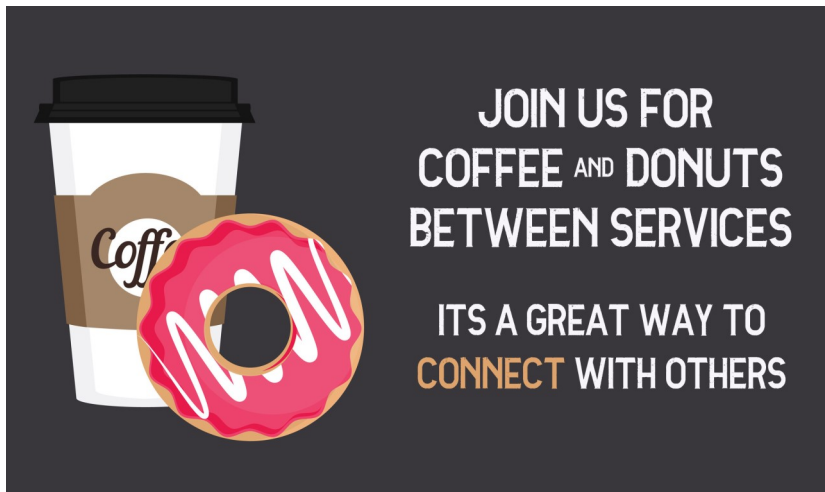
Two Sessions on Wednesday's in the Fellowship Hall.

Sunday Ministry Partner Sign-up Process

Our Sunday morning Service Team Leader positions are scheduled through Planning Center. We are using a tool in Planning Center called "Sign-up-Sheets". Rather than the office scheduling, now you will be able to choose which Sundays/services you'd like to serve.

At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.

We know that some of our married couples that use Planning Center share the same email address. If you do, here's what we need ONE of you to do: (One of you may keep your current password, but the other needs to create a new one). Enter the link to get to the sign-in page of Planning Center at <https://accounts.planningcenteronline.com>. Type in your email address and click the checkmark button. Remember, if you share an email address with another Planning Center user, you must keep track of which account you're accessing when you are signing up or making changes to your schedule.

La Cuchilla Community Update

April 2021

The CarePoint leadership and work team have been doing a great job strengthening the relationship with the parents of the children in the program and facilitating the completion of the kitchen and fence projects. In December 2020, 130 families received food bags, right before Christmas. The children finished the school year and enjoyed their school break.

The Guatemala school year begins in January. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, we could not resume in person programming this year. Specially since the CarePoint runs in a public school, operations were placed on hold. We had to wait until the Ministry of Education states the new procedures and protocols for schools.

In February, we had the blessing to do the inauguration of the new kitchen and fence at the school. We had the Supervisor of the Ministry of Education, parents and Hopechest Guatemala staff present to celebrate the completion of the projects. We feel blessed to be part of the community transformation at La Cuchilla. We are grateful for your support!

In March, food bags were delivered to families to keep supporting the children's nutrition at home.

The first devotional and first parent school of the year took place this month. A nurse from a nearby health post came to talk with the mothers about the importance of having good hygiene habits at home. We are not able to serve the children at the CarePoint due to Covid-19 restrictions, however, the leadership team is finding new ways to keep in touch with the parents to promote the self-development of the children. Parents play a critical role in this.

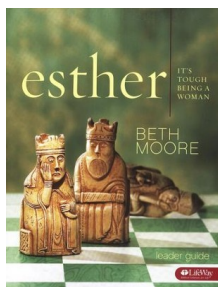

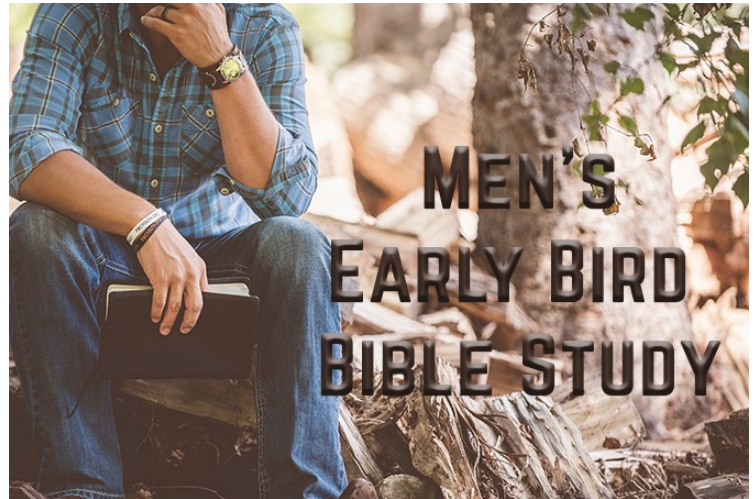

Financial Summary for March 2021

Giving Results

Giving was **over** budget by \$11,196 for the month of March and is **under** budget (\$2,958) for CYTD2021.

Tracked Giving was **over** by \$13,027 and Loose Plate was **under** by (\$1,831).

Spending

Spending was **under** budget by (\$27,766) for the month of March and **under** budget (\$50,673) for CYTD2021.

Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was **over** budget by \$3,721 for the month of March and **over** budget \$7,124 for CYTD2021.

Current enrollment in the Preschool is at the pre-COVID level.

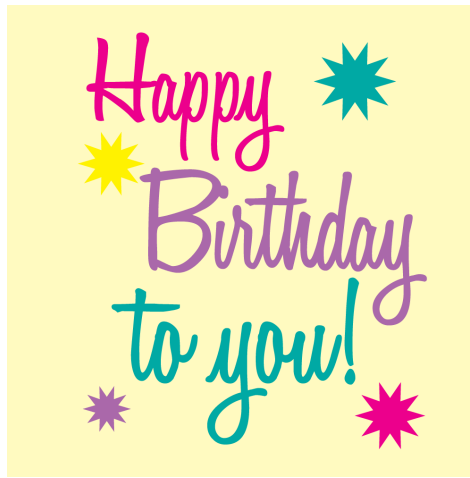
Net Operating Cash

As of March 31, 2021, Operating Cash is a **positive** \$40,073 which is a net **positive** change of \$26,445 from February 28, 2021.

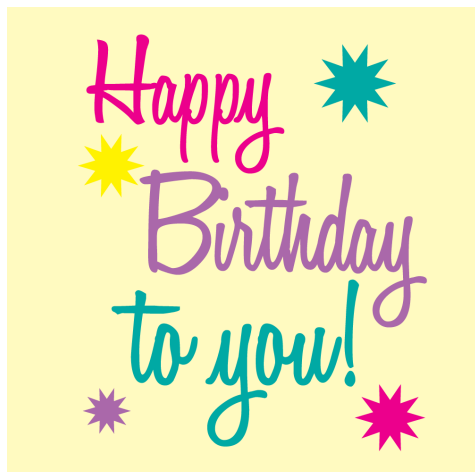

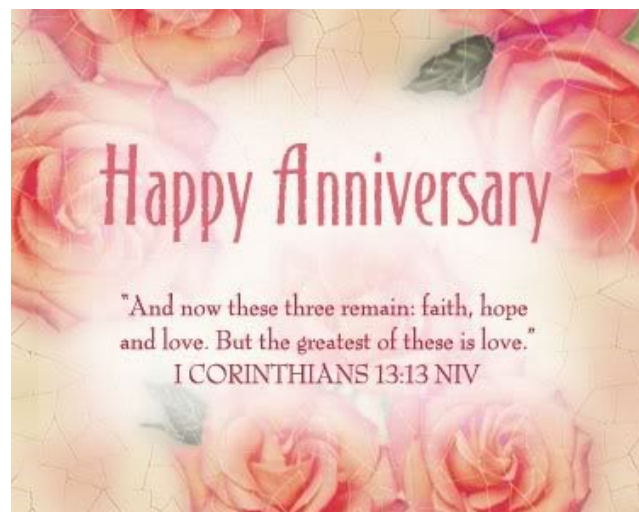
