

Look for the AZCEND truck before and after all services until 1:00 pm. You will receive a taxdeductible receipt for your donation.



Sunday Bible Study with Barry Ritchie Paul's First Letter to Timothy

Last Study is November 28

Sundays at 9:05 am OR 10:10 am in the Multi-Use Room. Who was your role model when you were growing up? Was it one of your parents, an uncle, or an older sister? Or was your role model someone you'd never met, like an astronaut or an Olympic athlete?

Our role models give us insight into what exactly our values are and, like it or not, often we find ourselves unknowingly serving as a role model for someone else – a child, a co-worker, or a total stranger. It's understandable that a strong figure like St. Paul was a role model to many people, but he especially served as a role model and mentor to Timothy. Now Timothy also had other role models: his mother, Eunice, and grandmother Lois were Jewish believers who helped shape his life and promote his spiritual growth (2 Timothy 1:5; 3:15). But Paul served that role for Timothy.

Timothy also has a special importance to us: He was the first "second generation" Christian mentioned in the New Testament and he became pastor of the church at Ephesus. As a young minister, Timothy faced all sorts of pressures, conflicts and challenges from the church and his surrounding culture. To counsel and encourage Timothy, Paul sent a very personal letter to remind and guide him as he faced challenges: First Timothy. This Bible study will dive into this letter to discover what values we should seek to model to the world as members of our community of faith here at Risen Savior. Led by Barry Ritchie, this 7-week study will show that First Timothy holds many lessons for us. The book we'll use from the Life Application Bible Study series will be available for purchase \$8.00 (the same book will be utilized in the Spring when we look at Second Timothy and Titus). Everyone is welcome. Come prepared to learn and participate.



At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.



Financial Summary for September 2021

Giving Results

Giving was *under* budget by (\$18,960) for the month of September and is *under* budget (\$21,675) for CYTD2021.

Tracked Giving was *under* by (\$15,857) and Loose Plate was *under* by (\$3,104).

Spending

Spending was *under* budget by (\$2,037) for the month of September and *under* budget (\$83,647) for CYTD2021.

Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was *under* budget by (\$19,910) for the month of September and *under* budget (\$61,526) for CYTD2021.

The Preschool has received a grant of \$10,000 per month for the next 23 months that will offset any shortfalls as well as provide additional funding for compensation and expenses.

Net Operating Cash

As of September 30, 2021, Operating Cash is a *negative* (\$54,960) which is a net *negative* change of (\$41,258) from August 31, 2021

Based on history and the cyclical nature of Giving and Expenses, this is expected at this time of the year.
