

# BUILDING UPDATE

Progress on the north building is moving along quickly. The parking around the Administration building is complete and being used. Inside the building, all the rooms are painted and all the tiles have been installed. The commercial kitchen is 90 % installed and most of the plumbing fixtures have been installed and are functioning. Inside the Worship Center, work has begun on the wall behind the platform and the tech booth is built. The building now has electricity and all the lighting except the lobby and Worship Center has been installed. The inner structure of the large cross outside the main entrance has been installed and is ready for the finished exterior. Over the next few weeks more sidewalks will be poured and work will continue on getting the site ready for the parking lot. Inside the climate control systems will be brought online and work will be done on the audio and video in the building. We are still hopeful to be worshiping in the new building in December!

Two Sessions on Wednesday's in the Fellowship Hall.


First session is from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm and second session is 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm.

June and July Report: La Cuchilla is a small village with a Children's June and July Keport: La Cuchilla is a small village with a population of 500 people. The CarePoint operates out of the local public school and is led by the school staff, parents of the students,

and the local community government. Most children don't finish school because they work with their parents during the harvest season to help support the family. The families lack resources to feed their children, resulting in malnourishment. The people in La Cuchilla are willing to work, and with the support of the school and local government there are opportunities for projects and programs to empower the community, improve education, and invest in the lives of the children.



Edgar is a 9 years old boy. His parents are teachers from other school in the same community. Paola, his mother, has been supporting the CarePoint as a volunteer. Edgar is not going to the CarePoint because of the COVID-19 restrictions. However, his mother wanted to keep serving her community through the Carepoint. Now, she is one of the volunteers who helps when help is needed. We are grateful for Paola and her family. We trust God will keep touching more parents' hearts, and they will join the Carepoint to serve the children and the community similar to what Paola is doing.

"Blessings to Hopechest and HopeChest Friends. My name is Paola and I'm one of the teachers in the community, from Canton Quila Public School. I teach 7th grade. My students are part of the Carepoint, and I'm grateful for that. My son is also part of the program. Your support started in the community just in time. We feel blessed to partner with you to serving the community." Paola

In July, we distributed school materials for 204 children. This is to keep supporting their educational development during the Coronavirus lock-down. Since March 15th, schools have been closed which affected the children's personal development. The government sends some school materials to them so that they continue studying at home. However, not all of them have access to TV or internet connection to attend the virtual classes.

At La Cuchilla Carepoint, we are blessed to have teachers supporting the CarePoint staff. The leadership and volunteers decided to put their gifts and talents to serve the children. They developed school worksheets to help the children's learning. The Carepoint gave school supplies and bags with the school material for 204 students. The staff followed up with the students through calls, videos and pictures. Now, parents and teachers are working together to keep supporting the children. We plan to keep sending the school material to the children on monthly basis until schools are reopened.



"Hi prayer friends, I hope you and your families are doing well. I want to thank God for the school materials. Since we cannot go to school, this helps me keep studying at home. Now, I have the opportunity to keep learning new things from home! Thank you for your support to our families! During this pandemic season many people have lost their jobs and could not provide food to their families. My family and I are very grateful! We hope this pandemic goes away soon. 





## Risen Savior Monthly Financial Review

The following is a summary of financial activity for Risen Savior Lutheran Church. If you would like more detailed reports, please contact our Business Manager, Susan Mello at susan.mello@rslcs.org.

#### Financial Summary for August 2020:

Below, you will see the detail for August financials. Please note that these results do not reflect the impact of our Paycheck Protection Loan.

#### Giving Results

Giving was *under* budget by (\$36,585) for the month of August and *under* budget by (\$74,281) CYTD20.

For CYTD20, we are at 93% of the budget for Giving. The shortfall is predominantly in Loose Plate giving.

#### Spending

Spending was *under* budget by (\$14,165) for the month of August and *under* budget by (\$143,014) CYTD20.

The Preschool has underspent due to control over variable costs such as, food and labor that has been impacted by lower enrollment.

The Church has put controls in place to monitor expenses and adjust as needed based on Giving.

In light of the decrease in Giving and Preschool Revenue, we continue to monitor expenses and limit based on necessity.

#### Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was *under* budget by (\$13,705) for the month of August and *under* budget (\$127,999) CYTD20.

Current enrollment at the Preschool is approximately 75% of the pre-COVID-19 levels.

#### Net Operating Cash

As of August 31, 2020, Operating Cash is a *negative* (\$162,516), which is a decrease of (\$54,474) from the end of July.

Please note that this does NOT include the impact of the PPP Loan.

This is significantly below our budgeted position for this time of the year, but we are putting controls in place to limit the effect of this through the end of the calendar year.
