Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

A little more than seven weeks ago, I received an email from Pastor Ron asking me if I was open to a conversation about ministry at Risen Savior. During this time, I ask for your prayers for me and my family, but also for Our Savior as they will soon be entering into a vacancy.

Thank you once again for this opportunity. We are humbled and excited. We are excited to work with Pastor Ron and the rest of the staff at Risen Savior as well as with all of you. We are excited to follow God into the future that He has already prepared for us knowing with all our hearts that God is going to do amazing things in us and through us that are only possible through Him. I leave you with the words of Paul from Ephesians 3, "Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen."



Sunday Ministry Partner Sign-up Process

Our Sunday morning Service Team Leader positions are scheduled through Planning Center. We are using a tool in Planning Center called "Sign-up-Sheets". Rather than the office scheduling, now you will be able to choose which Sundays/services you'd like to serve.

At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.

We know that some of our married couples that use Planning Center share the same email address. If you do, here's what we need ONE of you to do: (One of you may keep your current password, but the other needs to create a new one). Enter the link to get to the sign-in page of Planning Center at https://accounts.planningcenteronline.com. Type in your email address and click the checkmark button. Remember, if you share an email address with another Planning Center user, you must keep track of which account you're accessing when you are signing up or making changes to your schedule.






COLD-CASE CHRISTIANITY


