Greetings Risen Savoir Lutheran Church,

Over the past year at Concordia Seminary I have learned many important things needed to be a good pastor. The last year has been an extremely rewarding experience. I am very grateful to have the opportunity to go to the seminary in order to be a pastor in the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod. Learning about Christ, and the best way to share the gospel with people has been great. Here is an update on how the past year has went and some things I have learned:

In our practical theology class we have developed essential pastoral skills. For example, we took a class on how to reach people in the community and get them into church. The goal of this class was to give us the skills needed to grow the church. We also learned useful skills such as how to teach people how to have a good quality devotional life. In this class I learned how to teach people different types of devotions in addition to reading. Such as praying on a morning walk, listening to Christian music, and writing prayers based on Bible verses.

The seminary has us take classes about preaching in our homiletics classes. The class was based on how to have a meaningful sermon which remain focused on Christ. A sermon that will be impactful and memorable to the congregation. I had a great professor for this course who taught me a lot of valuable lessons. Giving sermons at my field work church and in the chapel was a wonderful experience. Another discipline we study at the seminary is systematics. It is a great class type about Lutheran theology. They teach about how to apply Lutheran theology from books to real-life situations. We went through the book of concord and key aspects of Lutheran theology. We talked in detail about how these teachings matter and how they can be used to help people grow in their faith.

I also have been taking a lot of classes about the books of the Bible. In this class we learn the best way to teach people what the Bible says. It has a big focus on how to teach an effective Bible study. Taking the time to carefully read the Bible is a lot of fun. It is a great thing to do on a daily basis. I want to thank you all for being such an awesome home church. Thank you especially for the grant which will help me here at the seminary. It means so much to me. I could not do this without you

all. I look forward to become a pastor one day and teaching people that through

Christ there is

forgiveness of sins and life everlasting.

## Sunday Ministry Partner Sign-up Process

Our Sunday morning Service Team Leader positions are scheduled through Planning Center. We are using a tool in Planning Center called "Sign-up-Sheets". Rather than the office scheduling, now you will be able to choose which Sundays/services you'd like to serve.

At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.

We know that some of our married couples that use Planning Center share the same email address. If you do, here's what we need ONE of you to do: (One of you may keep your current password, but the other needs to create a new one). Enter the link to get to the sign-in page of Planning Center at https://accounts.planningcenteronline.com. Type in your email address and click the checkmark button. Remember, if you share an email address with another Planning Center user, you must keep track of which account you're accessing when you are signing up or making changes to your schedule.


## New Women's Ministry Bible Study

Trust God more than your feelings






Women's Evening Bible Study: Quenched (by His Word)
